Registration for the ARRA EHR Incentive Program opened January 3, 2011. CMS is encouraging eligible providers to register with or without having a certified EHR implemented. Please review the [Incentive Registration Process.pdf](#) to better understand the steps needed to register for incentives. This document includes links to the CMS registration and attestation sites.

What will be needed when registering?

Eligible Professionals

- National Provider Identifier (NPI).
- National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) User ID and Password.
- Payee Tax Identification Number (if you are reassigning your benefits).
- Payee National Provider Identifier (NPI) (if you are reassigning your benefits).

The SuiteMed IMS CMS Certification Number is not a must for registration, but can be included at that time. It is however a must of the attestation process for either the Medicare or Medicaid incentive program. Follow the steps outlined in the [Requesting a CMS EHR Certification ID Number.pdf](#) to obtain a SuiteMed IMS CMS Certification Number.

Hospitals

- CMS Identity and Access Management (I&A) User ID and Password.
- CMS Certification Number (CCN).
- National Provider Identifier (NPI).
- Hospital Tax Identification Number.

Note: Hospitals can qualify for both programs and if they are thinking of going for both they must register as a Dual Provider.
